Bull nutrition and development has been conducted with the assistance from the professionals at Suther Feeds, Inc. Our nutrition and herd health have been designed to ensure the longevity of the bulls. The disposition of the bulls reflects the way they have been developed.

Fertility Exam And Herd Health

Breeding soundness evaluations were performed by Dr. Jeffrey Tharp, Holyoke Veterinary Service at Holyoke, CO 970-854-3800. Bulls are guaranteed breeders and sell with an individual fertility exam certificate. They have all been semen checked prior to the sale. Heifer pelvic measurements and repro tract scores were performed by Dr. Jeffrey Tharp, Holyoke Veterinary Service at Holyoke, CO 970-854-3800. All lots have been vaccinated for IBR, PI3, BVD, 7-way, BRSV and Haemophilus and have been poured and injected with Decctomax. All bulls have been administered Vitamin E. Heifers have been vaccinated with Bovi-Shield Gold FP5 VL5. All lots tested negative for PI BVD and are AM, NH, CA, DD and M1 free by test or pedigree.

Performance And Fertility Data

EPDs printed in this catalog are as of February 6, 2026. EPD adjustments based upon submission of yearling weights and scrotal measurements will be reflected on an updated Supplement Sheet. A Supplement Sheet will provide updated EPDs, scrotal and heifer pelvic area. All lots with the HD50K logo have been parent verified and sell with genomically enhanced EPDs.

Bulls are guaranteed for 90 days from the first turnout against breeding injury. Buyer should notify Vision Angus as soon as possible should injury occur and prior to the injured bull being sold for salvage. We ask that all claims for credit be made known prior to September 1, 2026. This is not a mortality insurance policy nor does it cover mismanagement or neglect. Our heifers also sell with a first season breeding guarantee.

AMERICAN ANGUS ASSOCIATION SELECTION TOOLS

We're committed to "Driving the science of better breeding" by providing you with the American Angus Association selection tools but we're doing so with more reliability and predictability through genomically enhanced EPDs.

Calving Ease Direct (CED)

is expressed as a difference in percentage of unassisted births, with a higher value indicating greater calving ease in first-calf heifers. It predicts the average difference in ease with which a sire's calves will be born when he is bred to first-calf heifers.

Birth Weight EPD (BW)

expressed in pounds, is a predictor of a sire's ability to transmit birth weight to his progeny compared to that of other sires.

Weaning Weight EPD (WW)

expressed in pounds, is a predictor of a sire's ability to transmit weaning growth to his progeny compared to that of other sires. For example, you can expect progeny from a sire with a 60 WW EPD to weigh 20 lbs heavier on average at weaning than progeny from a sire with a 40 WW EPD.

Yearling Weight EPD (YW)

expressed in pounds, is a predictor of a sire's ability to transmit yearling growth to his progeny compared to that of other sires.

Scrotal Circumference EPD (SC)

expressed in centimeters, is a predictor of the difference in transmitting ability for scrotal size compared to that of other sires.

Docility (DOC)

expressed as a difference in yearling cattle temperament, with a higher value indicating more favorable docility. It predicts the average difference of progeny from a sire in comparison with another sire's calves. In herds where temperament problems are not an issue, this expected difference would not be realized.

Heifer Pregnancy (HP)

is a selection tool to increase the probability or chance of a sire's daughters becoming pregnant as first-calf heifers during a normal breeding season. A higher EPD is the more favorable direction and the EPD is reported in percentage units.

Maternal Milk EPD (Milk)

is a predictor of a sire's genetic merit for milk and mothering ability as expressed in his daughters as compared to daughters of other sires. In other words, it is that part of a calf's weaning weight attributed to milk and mothering ability.

Carcass Weight EPD (CW)

expressed in pounds, is a predictor of the difference in hot carcass weight of a sire's progeny compared to progeny of other sires.

Marbling EPD (Marb)

expressed as a fraction of the difference in USDA marbling score of a sire's progeny compared to progeny of other sires.

Ribeye Area EPD (RE)

expressed in square inches, is a predictor of the difference in ribeye area of a sire's progeny compared to progeny of other sires.

Maternal Weaned Calf Value (\$M)

an index, expressed in dollars per head, predicts profitability differences from conception to weaning with the underlying breeding objective assuming that individuals retain their own replacement females within herd and sell the rest of the cull female and all male progeny as feeder calves. The model assumes commercial producers will replace 25% of their breeding females in the first generation and 20% of their breeding females in each subsequent generation. Traits included are as follows: calving ease direct, calving ease maternal, weaning weight, milk, heifer pregnancy, docility, mature cow weight, claw set and foot angle.

Weaned Calf Value (\$W)

an index value expressed in dollars per head, is the expected average difference in future progeny performance for preweaning merit. \$W includes both revenue and cost adjustments associated with differences in birth weight, weaning direct growth, maternal milk and mature cow size.

Feedlot Value (\$F)

an index value expressed in dollars per head, is the expected average difference in future progeny performance for postweaning merit compared to progeny of other sires.

Grid Value (\$G)

an index value expressed in dollars per head, is the expected average difference in future progeny performance for carcass grid merit compared to progeny of other sires.

Beef Value (\$B)

an index value expressed in dollars per head, is the expected average difference in future progeny performance for postweaning and carcass value compared to progeny of other sires.

Combined Value (\$C)

an index, expressed in dollars per head, which includes all traits that make up both Maternal Weaned Calf Value (\$M) and Beef Value (\$B) with the objective that commercial producers will replace 20% of their breeding females per year with replacement heifers retained within their own herd. The remaining cull heifer and steer progeny are then assumed to be sent to the feedlot where the producers retain ownership of those cattle and sell them on a quality-based carcass merit grid. Expected progeny differences (EPDs) directly influencing a combined index: calving ease direct (CED) and maternal (CEM), weaning weight (WW), yearling weight (YW), maternal milk (Milk), heifer pregnancy (HP), docility (DOC), mature cow weight (MW), foot angle (Angle), claw set (Claw), dry matter intake (DMI), marbling (Marb), carcass weight (CW), ribeye area (RE) and fat thickness (Fat).

Genomic test results have already been factored into their individual EPDs providing you with higher accuracy EPDs that are the equivalent of that individual already having produced and recorded 8-33 calves depending on the trait measured. For commercial and seedstock producers that's valuable insight for more accurate selection, easier identification of genetic outliers and more reliability and predictability for genetic progress.

The following table provides you the progeny equivalent for some of the traits measured through genomic testing resulting in higher accuracy EPDs.
